
"JESUS CHRIST: TRUE MAN"

This seems obvious but. . .


- 1) Some people deny that there ever was a man named "Jesus Christ."
- 2) Some believe that Jesus just looked like a man but was not really human.








In your opinion, which picture looks the most like Jesus?
